From 2023, Burgundy hosts a network of 3 cultural and tourist sites that promote Bourgogne, its heritage, its wines and its Climats.

BOURGOGNE: A THOUSAND-YEAR-OLD CULTURAL HERITAGE

Bourgogne has been known throughout the world for its history, its heritage, its vineyards and its wines. It is indeed the birthplace of a **great viticultural model**; it is the archetype of terroir-based vineyards and is constantly searching to achieve results that are embodied in the "*Climats*". Nowhere else in the world have people sought to link wine production to its place of origin in such a precise and intimate manner, and this has been the case for centuries. This explains why the "Climats du vignoble de Bourgogne", within the zone from "Dijon" to "Maranges", were registered in 2015 as a Unesco World Heritage Site, in recognition of their universal value.


The Cité in Chablis, Gateway to the northern vineyards

Located in the heart of the village, a stone's throw from the vineyards, the Cité is housed in an authentic and intimate medieval historic building: **the Petit Pontigny** cellar, a place highly charged with History, as it is **one of the monastic cradles** that shaped wine production in Bourgogne. It will promote the heritage and culture related to the world of vines and wine in the Bourgogne viticultural area and will highlight the wines of northern Bourgogne: **Chablis, Grand Auxerrois, Châtillonnais.**

The Cité in Beaune, The heart of the Bourgogne wine-region

The biggest of the three sites embodies the History, expertise, and heritage of Bourgogne, while highlighting the different particularities of the winegrowing areas (Chablis, Grand Auxerrois, Châtillonnais, Côte de Nuits, Côte de Beaune, Côte Chalonnaise and Mâconnais). The Beaune site is a lively place committed to green tourism and sustainable practices, and hosts the main interpretation center for the *Climats du vignoble de Bourgogne*, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.


The Cité in Mâcon, Gateway to the southern vineyards



THE CITÉ IN BEAUNE

THE HEART OF THE BOURGOGNE WINE-REGION

Unique in Bourgogne! Take a walk along the outdoor ramp (free access) to admire the vineyards (Inee access) to administrate vineyards from the panoramic terrace, 20 meters above the ground.



Located near the historic city of Beaune, in a landscaped park covering more than 10 hectares, the Cité des Climats et vins de Bourgogne will be the flagship of a brand-new neighborhood comprising a four-star hotel, restaurants, a wine and gourmet food-themed shopping mall, and an events hall.

The biggest of the three sites embodies the History, expertise, and heritage of Bourgogne, while highlighting the different particularities of the winegrowing areas (Chablis, Grand Auxerrois, Châtillonnais, Côte de Nuits, Côte de Beaune, Côte Chalonnaise and Mâconnais). In particular, it promotes the notion of Climats, a global reference for terroir-based winegrowing, inscribed upon the UNESCO World Heritage List.

THE CLIMATS OF BOURGOGNE

A space dedicated to the Climats of Bourgogne, inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List



On 4 July 2015, the **Climats of Bourgogne** were inscribed on the **UNESCO World Heritage List**, which showcases unique cultural landscapes around the world. The area covered by the label includes the vineyards of the Côte de Beaune and Côte de Nuits, and their 40 winegrowing towns and villages. The Cité des Climats et vins in Beaune will promote this inscription by dedicating a specific area within the visitor experience. Visitors will be immersed in an exploration of this heritage, this remarkable patchwork of plots, as well as the culture and traditions inherited over 2,000 years of history and work in the vines and wines that led to the establishment of the **Climats**. The Cité in Beaune will thus become the **main center of reference** for the Climats of Bourgogne.

AN ECO-SUSTAINABLE CONSTRUCTION

This architectural jewel, 24 meters high, is an example in terms of eco-sustainable construction:

- The use of bio-composite materials with the use of hemp concrete for the construction of wood-frame facades. This plant-based natural insulator, produced in France and supplied in bulk (to avoid the use of plastic materials), will provide excellent energy efficiency and comfort of use while reducing the environmental impact of the building.
- The use of local geosourced materials such as Comblanchien stone for the base, soil from Mont Saint-Vincent for the interior coating, and whitewash for the exterior rendering and insulation binder.
- **Production of renewable energy** with the installation of photovoltaic panels and a heat pump.
- **Permeable space** with integrated rainwater recovery and eco-management.
- **Outdoor vegetation** above the scenographic platform with wine stocks planted.

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


