

On July 4, 2015, UNESCO added the the Climats du vignoble de Bourgogne to its World Heritage List. A decade later, this designation continues to significantly influence the region.

Through this anniversary, The Cité des Climats et vins de Bourgogne is reaffirming the significance of this inscription and its role in the promotion of this exceptional heritage.

For a duration of two months, this exhibition highlights the architectural heritage of the Climats du vignoble de Bourgogne. In collaboration with the CotedorPix Association, it presents about forty photographs curated by a jury, showcasing stone walls, cellars, estates, villages, and historic sites that are emblematic of this distinctive region.

Open to everyone, the exhibition merges education with immersion. Attendees have the opportunity to vote for their preferred photograph, which will be honored with the People's Choice Award during the closing ceremony. This event serves as an artistic and cultural tribute to the wine heritage of Burgundy.

At the Cité, attendees can partake in guided tours that delve into the history and craftsmanship of winemaking, culminating in a tasting of a Climat wine. Simultaneously, children can engage with the vineyards through a specially crafted game booklet.

From the fifth floor of the Cité, a guided landscape reading, conducted by a specialist, will enable visitors to appreciate the panoramic views of the vineyards and gain a deeper understanding of these remarkable landscapes. The scientific workshops led by "Les Petits Débrouillards" will stimulate visitors' curiosity regarding geology and the development of terroirs.

On the creative front, a drawing competition and a collaborative mosaic depicting scenes envisioned by the participants will enhance this celebration, providing an experience that is both enjoyable and engaging.

For the second consecutive year, the Cité des Climats et Vins de Bourgogne is embracing urban art within its premises. In this edition, Mr. Pee presents a creative interpretation of vineyard elements, depicting the intriguing narrative of a hybrid character, part man and part plant, in collaboration with the Appartelier gallery.



Mr. Pee, an iconic figure in Parisian street art residing in Montreuil, initially made his mark as a designer before transitioning to the streets with his vibrant creations that blend humor, poetry, and diverse techniques (cut wood, paper, canvas).



INAUGURATION OF THE FALC


